Limited grants are available for full funding of *Inside the Outdoors*® Rethink Resources Traveling Scientist for TK to High School students! This grant is limited to schools in Orange County. If your school is selected you will be registered for your programs based on the dates listed on your application and program availability. More than one grade per school may be eligible for this grant. We have a lower elementary (TK - 2nd) and upper elementary to High School version of the program. Rethink Resources uses trash to explore the connection between humans and the natural world. Through hands-on activities that focus on the five R's: Reduce, Reuse, Rot, Repurpose, and Recycle, students will develop a deeper understanding of the importance of natural resources and how we can conserve them by producing less waste.
